Revising the Highways Improvement Plan

A new Highways Working Group of councillors and residents has been formed to renew the Highways Improvement Plan following the growth of Loose parish. They are currently consulting with the five schools within the new boundary to listen to their issues and priorities, before taking these to KCC Highways. Traffic issues from nearby developments and junction changes impact all of us, and the group are seeking constructive proposals to put to KCC. Litter picking & environmental opportunities

As the Parish has tripled in size, we still have many areas that are not yet covered by the Love Loose Hate Litter scheme. This is a large team of volunteers quietly litter picking across the Parish. The pickers choose the area they wish



to cover (often around where they live) and pick in their own spare time. We are so grateful to them all. There are other practical opportunities such as the pond works and supporting the Loose Amenities Association monthly working parties in the valley on the 3rd Sunday of each month.
