Minutes of the Neighbourhood Plan Steering Group Meeting

Tuesday 16 April 2024 at 2.30pm

1. Introductions

The group introduced themselves.

2. Group's Terms of Reference:

Following a lengthy discussion the group agreed a draft document for approval by Loose Parish Council at their meeting on 20 May.

3. Neighbourhood Plan Road Map:

The overview of key stages was discussed.

4. Defining the Neighbourhood Plan area:

- i. The status of the new boundary of Loose parish was discussed and the issues that may be raised.
- ii. It was noted that the new Parish Boundary and queries raised are being looked at by Cllr Brian Clark.
 The Group **agreed** that Brian Clark would be chased on the matter.

5. Support for development of the Neighbourhood Plan:

- Following a discussion about use of planning consultants, local volunteers etc. The group agreed that Neighbourhood Planning Consultants would be necessary and that MJW would give this some thought.
- Software that was able to compare the similarities between Loose Neighbour
 Plan and the North Loose Neighbourhood plan was discussed.
 The group agreed that MW would investigate.

iii. The group **agreed** that a specification would need to be put together to enable consultants to quote for assisting with the Neighbourhood Plan.

6. Funding the work:

- i. The group agreed that the cost of the Neighbourhood Plan could be in the region of £30000.00.
- Sources of funding were discussed and the following were mentioned: Locality, LPC, LAA.
 The group agreed to monitor Locality and work up a grant application.
 The group agreed that JA would investigate funding and JB would contact other Clerks to ascertain their methods of funding their Neighbourhood Plans.
